What is the Academy?

- 12 month timeline
- 3 in-person 2-day workshops
 - Interactive exercises
 - Applying skills to case studies
 - Planning, executing, and presenting on demonstration project

Demonstration project = temporary project to reduce speed on a dangerous local corridor through creative place-making, tactical urbanism, or engineering measures

What is the Academy?

- 6 monthly distance learning modules
 - 1. Planning and designing for active transportation
 - 2. Planning and designing for transit
 - 3. Designing and operating for Vision Zero
 - 4. Creative place-making and prototyping to reduce speed
 - 5. Curbside management strategies for new mobility options
 - 6. Planning for freight logistics

Who is the Academy for?

- Cohort of 10 practitioners from each jurisdiction including:
 - Managing public works engineers
 - Managing & mid-level transportation engineers
 - Managing transportation planners
 - Transportation budget decision-makers
- 3 jurisdictions will be selected for the Academy

Who is the Academy for?

- Eligibility criteria:
 - Population of at least 100,000
 - Have adopted at least one of the following:
 - Bike/pedestrian master plan
 - Complete Streets policy
 - Vision Zero policy
 - Multimodal design guidelines
 - Must commit to all requirements of the Safe Streets Academy

Who is the Academy for?

Requirements:

- Send the 10-person cohort to all trainings & participate in all distance-learning modules
- Complete a demonstration project
- Raise \$8,000 in matching funds/in-kind donations for the demonstration project
- Work with us to produce a case study on the demonstration project
- Host one in-person training (meeting space, breakfast & lunch, transportation to site visit)
- Present safety recommendations to local DOT & community
- Join the Road to Zero Coalition: nsc.org/roadtozero
